SUBJECT: Closure of the Claims Coordinating Office (CCO) – Hurricane Isabel

During the period of September 18-19, 2003, Hurricane Isabel caused extensive wind and flood damage in North Carolina. As a result of this event, the NFIP Bureau and Statistical Agent established a CCO in Carey, North Carolina.

The CCO and the North Carolina Insurance Underwriting Association has matched and single-adjusted 1,600 losses during this event, and the submission of new claims has diminished. Therefore, the Federal Emergency Management Agency has authorized the CCO to close, effective October 10, 2003.
