SUBJECT:	Loss of Community Rating System (CRS) Discount Report

In accordance with the May 1, 2008, Program changes outlined in Clearinghouse Bulletin W-08023 (<u>http://bsa.nfipstat.com/wyobull/w-08023.pdf</u>), significant premium increases will develop for policies effective on or after May 1, 2008, in 830 communities. The scope of the change is further explained in Clearinghouse Bulletin W-08030 (<u>http://bsa.nfipstat.com/wyobull/w-08030.pdf</u>).

To assist with identifying policies that will lose their CRS credit at their next renewal, the NFIP Bureau and Statistical Agent has developed a one-time report, which is being provided to your vendor (if applicable). This report will contain policies that are statistically reported as Post-FIRM structures located in a Special Flood Hazard Area where the lowest floor elevation used for rating is at least 1 foot or more below the Base Flood Elevation. (Post-FIRM V-Zone buildings with unfinished breakaway wall enclosures and the machinery or equipment is at or above the base flood elevation should not be impacted by this program change.)
