SUBJECT:	Extension of Renewal Grace Period in the State of Missouri

The Insurance Department in the State of Missouri has taken various steps to address the potentially adverse impact of disruption of mail delivery and displacement from residences on the renewal of homeowners policies in this State.

With regard to NFIP policies, which are subject to Federal regulation, I am directing the WYO companies and the NFIP Direct Program to provide a 60-day extension of the renewal grace period for any policyholders in the State of Missouri who are hindered by the severe flooding from renewing their policies on a timely basis. This extension is applicable to all affected policies with a renewal grace period ending between June 6, 2008 and August 5, 2008. June 6 marked the onset of the flooding in the State.
