SUBJECT: Adjusted Dates of Loss – Hurricane Ike
AL, AR, IN, FL, KS, MI, MO, OK, MS

Hurricane Ike produced torrential rain and widespread flood damage in the States of Alabama, Arkansas, Indiana, Florida, Kansas, Michigan, Missouri, Oklahoma, and Mississippi. In Clearinghouse Bulletin W-08064, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) assigned FICO numbers to track the claims arising from this event. FEMA has now adjusted the Dates of Loss for the event, as shown below.
