Extended Eligibility for Preferred Risk Policies in Five California Communities

On December 2, 2008, revised Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) were issued for Sutter County, Live Oak City, and Yuba City, California. On December 8, 2008, revised maps were issued for Sacramento County and the City of Sacramento. Prior to the remapping, many property owners in these communities purchased Preferred Risk Policies (PRPs) because the revised FIRMs placed them in Special Flood Hazard Areas removing their eligibility for the low-cost PRP.

Because of the substantial time between the remapping effort and the effective date of the revised maps, FEMA has decided that PRPs in these communities, renewing before the following dates, will be allowed 1 additional year as a PRP before they must be rewritten to the standard X-Zone policy.
