SUBJECT: Extension of Revision to Compliance Policy Date for Large-Font Policy Documents

Effective immediately, FEMA is extending the stay for compliance with Section 5 of Attachment A of NFIP WYO Bulletin W-13070, "June 1, 2014 Program Changes" dated December 16, 2013. The first revision was announced in NFIP WYO Bulletin W-14027, "Revision to Compliance Date for Large-Font Policy Documents" on May 30, 2014. The implementation of the requirement to mail out revised policies that comply with 42 U.S.C. Section 4013a is being delayed an additional 31 days to allow FEMA to consult with our WYO partners as outlined in the Homeowner Flood Insurance Affordability Act of 2014.
