SUBJECT: Change of Eligibility Dates for the Grace Period Extension for Payment of National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) Renewal Premiums

Bulletin W-16057 dated August 22, 2016 advised of the waiver of the Standard Flood Insurance Policy (SFIP) renewal provisions to provide that the 30-day grace period for receipt of the renewal premium payment after a policy's expiration date is extended for an additional ninety (90) calendar days. Bulletin W-16057 stated that this extension was applicable to all policies with a grace period ending August 11, 2016, through September 10, 2016.

This bulletin advises that the eligibility period for this waiver is now extended to include all policies with a grace period ending July 27, 2016, through September 10, 2016.

This waiver applies to all NFIP policies, whether issued by the NFIP Servicing Agent or a Write Your Own Company, written for properties in the following parishes in Louisiana: Acadia, Ascension, Avoyelles, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Evangeline, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, St. Helena, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Vermilion, Washington and West Feliciana.
